

The ZIP file entitled "Demo" is the KML Tips and Tricks Demo theater presentation from the 2008 ESRI UC. Also included is the associated data for the demos.

I have tried to generalize URLs and paths as much as possible. To have the least difficulties observe the following instructions.

1. Install ArcGIS Server if you haven't already.
2. Extract the zip file in your C:\ directory (it should expand to about 900MB in a directory called C:\Documents).
3. Give read/write permissions for the ArcGISSoc user to the C:\Documents folder.

4. Create the following services in your server's root folder:

MapServices:

a) Portland

b) HTBService

GPServices:

a) MIB

5. Copy the contents of C:\Documents\Data\UCs\UC2008\KML Demos\Kml to C:\Inetpub\wwwroot\ArcGIS\Kml
